Ha-Na Jang loses no time in winning her second championship on the LPGA Tour by emerging victorious at the HSBC Women's Champions tournament!

HONMA GOLF CO., LTD. (head office: Roppongi Hills Mori Tower 35F, 6-10-1 Roppongi, Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative director & president: Yasuki Ito) signed a contract for the use of clubs and articles with professional golfer Ha-Na Jang, winner of the HSBC Women's Champions on the LPGA Tour (March 3 to 6) at the Sentosa Golf Club, Singapore. This is Ha-Na Jang's second LPGA Tour victory.

Ha-Na Jang grabbed the lead by posting a 66 on the second day of the HSBC Women's Champions, a tournament that can only be played by the world's highest-ranking golfers and that has also been described by many as the Asian Major, and maintained her lead on the third day. Tied for the top spot as she headed into the final day, Jang secured a birdie on the twelfth hole and proceeded to drain a couple of more birdies on the thirteenth and fourteenth holes with a masterful display of the long putt. Propelled by the momentum that she had built in this fashion, Jang scored another birdie on the sixteenth hole. On the par-5 eighteenth hole, she struck the ball with her TW727 3-wood club on her second shot from 194 yards out from the pin and brought the ball onto the nearside of the green. By cleanly sinking a two-meter putt on her next shot, Ha-Na Jang successfully secured her second victory of the still-young season.

Ha-Na Jang has rocketed off to an impressive start to only her second season on the LPGA Tour with four top-10 finishes, including two victories, in her five appearances thus far. Having already attained her goal of winning two tournaments this season in just her fifth competition, Ha-Na Jang is certainly going to be one to watch as the season progresses. She will also no doubt participate in the 31st Summer Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro later this year.

TEAM HONMA also put up a hugely impressive fight at the Daikin Orchid Ladies Golf Tournament (Ryukyu Golf Club, Okinawa), a JLPGA competition that was held at the same time. Seven members of TEAM HONMA survived the preliminary round and the tournament ended with Ritsuko Ryu in second place and Bo-Mee Lee in sixth place. Four members of the team finished in the top ten. These results are a testament to the depth of the high-caliber players that belong to TEAM HONMA.

In the course of aspiring to win thirty tournaments worldwide this year, TEAM HONMA will once again demonstrate the advantages of our TOUR WORLD x VIZARD clubs on tours around the globe during the 2016 season. We hope that you will continue to support TEAM HONMA as we endeavor to reach our goal.
