

HONMA Golf Tour member SO YEON RYU clinches
Rookie of the Year honors—USLPGA

Tokyo, Japan, Honma Golf, INC - The USLPGA announced on Oct/29/2012 that HONMA Golf Tour member So Yeon Ryu has mathematically clinched 2012 Louise Suggs Rolex Rookie of the Year honors with three tournaments remaining in the 2012 season.

Ryu outlasted Lexi Thompson for the top rookie honor on the strength of 14 top-10 finishes through 22 events, including a victory at the Jamie Farr Toledo Classic. And Ryu is currently 9th position in money rank. The 22-year-old earned LPGA Tour membership by winning the 2011 U.S. Women's Open as a member of the Korea LPGA (KLPGA).
